



Suggestions for using our film

The film is designed as a bite sized introduction to the issue of boundaries. It is a starting point that we hope will generate discussion. You might want to give some thought about how you plan to use this resource.

The film could be used;

- Individually – the film can be a useful way of doing a bit of ongoing formation on your own although we would encourage you to have someone you can reflect on any issues that arise for you with a colleague or mentor.
- Deanery Groups – the film is designed as a discussion resource and it can be helpful to pause the film, especially when questions are suggested, so that the group can share their own experiences and concerns.
- Diocesan Meetings – it might be used at larger gatherings of clergy. We would encourage that there is time for participants to break into smaller groups to aid discussion and then collective feedback.
- As part of other training – the film might be used as part of wider ongoing formation events such as safeguarding, clergy well-being etc., and we again encourage small group discussions so that the issue of boundaries can be put into context and promote further exploration and sharing of personal experience.
